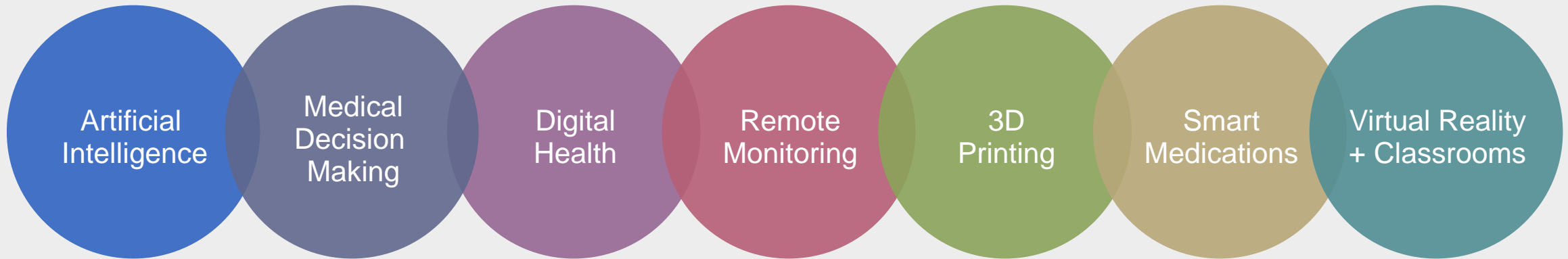

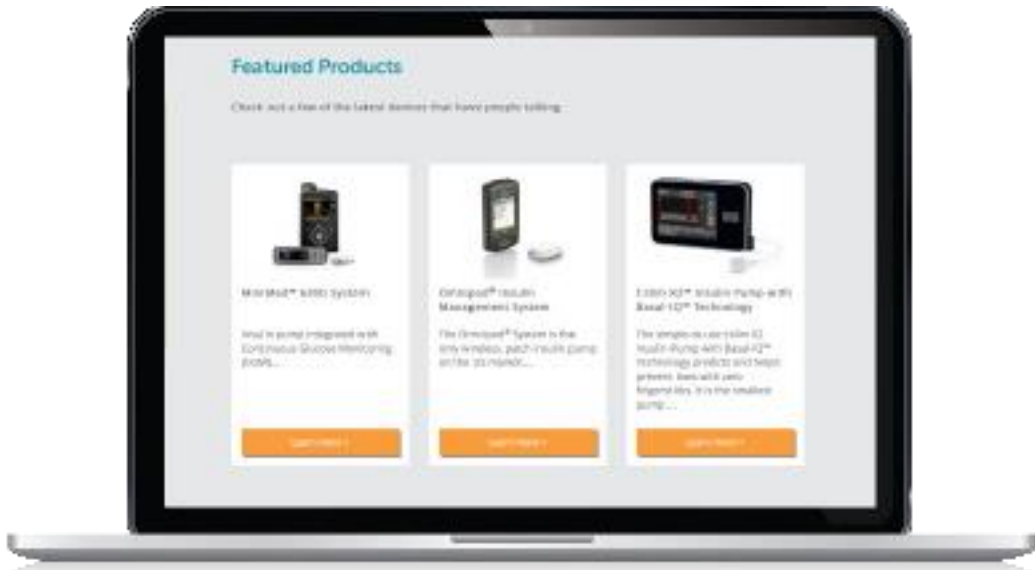
Introducing DANA

In the **Education Section**, diabetes educators will explore on-demand and live courses and webinars for both beginner and advanced levels

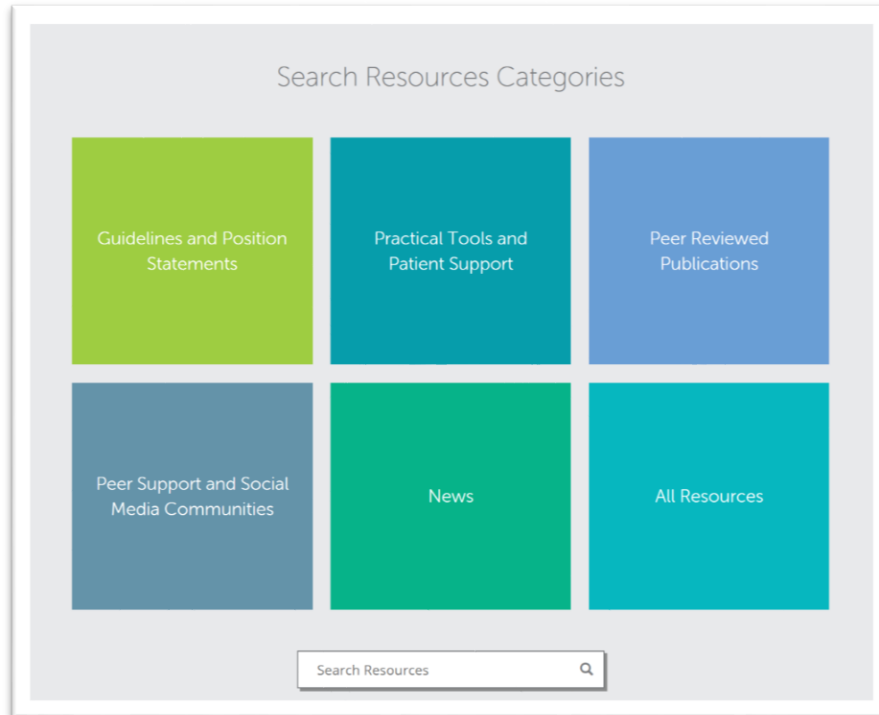

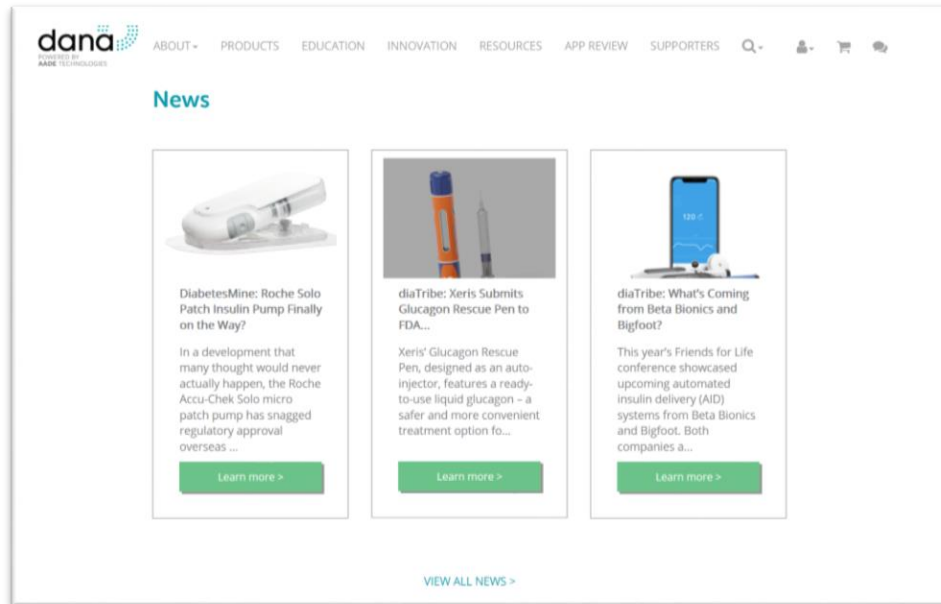

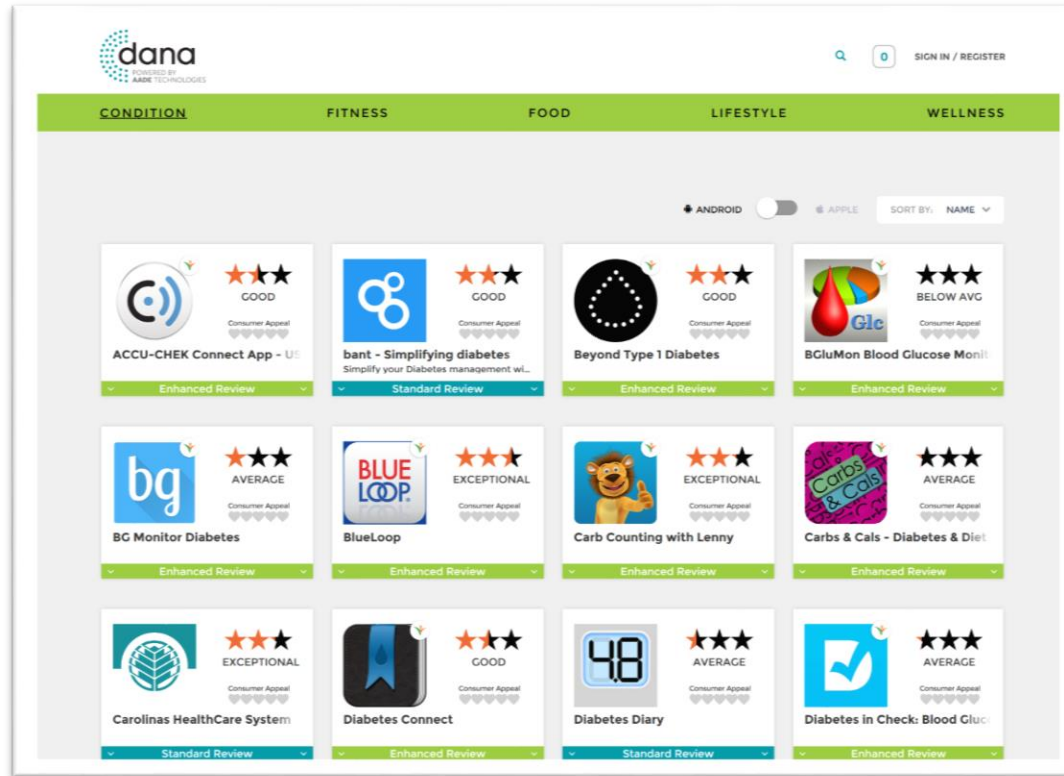
Growth of App Technology
